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For the twenty-first year, the Darrin Fresh Water Institute (DFWI) has continued the Aquatic Plant Identification Program. This program was initiated as a public service for the Lake George basin, in which individuals could bring specimens to DFWI for identification. In return, it assisted DFWI in locating new Eurasian watermilfoil and Curly-leaf Pondweed sites throughout the Lake George basin. DFWI now provides the opportunity for anyone in New York State to have plant specimens verified. This also enables us to maintain a list of locations of invasive aquatic plants such as Waterchestnut (*Trapa natans*), Curly-leaf Pondweed (*Potamogeton crispus*), Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*), and Fanwort (*Cabomba caroliniana*) in New York State. In 2004, we added Variable Milfoil (*Myriophyllum heterophyllum*), European Frogbit (*Hydrocharis morsus-ranae*) and Parrotfeather (*Myriophyllum aquaticum*) to our tabulated lists of exotic species in New York State. In 2005, we added an exotic macroalga, Starry Stonewort (*Nitellopsis obtusa*) and in 2006, we added Brazilian Elodea (*Egeria densa*). In 2008, we have added Hydrilla (*Hydrilla verticillatum*).

During 2008, thirteen specimens were received and identified (Table 1). Four of the specimens were Eurasian watermilfoil. The remaining exotic invasive species identified were more typically terrestrial species including Purple loosestrife (*Lythrum salicaria*), Common reed (*Phragmites australis*) and Japanese knotweed (*Fallopia japonica*). At the conclusion of 2008, 312 lakes and rivers in 53 counties had confirmed populations of Eurasian watermilfoil, 151 lakes and rivers systems in 46 counties had confirmed populations of Curly-leaf Pondweed and 34 lakes and rivers in 8 counties had Fanwort. Waterchestnut was found mainly in the Hudson and Mohawk Rivers systems; however, 53 lakes and 26 counties were reported. We report 10 lakes and river systems in 10 counties with confirmed populations of European Frogbit and 46 lakes in 13 counties had Variable Milfoil. Parrotfeather is currently reported for six lakes in Nassau and Suffolk counties of New York State. First reported in New York State in 1981, Starry Stonewort

is present mainly in Central New York, reported in bays peripheral to Lake Ontario, the St Lawrence River, and Oneida Lake in Oswego County, along with Chautauqua Lake, Lake Bonaparte and Lake Moraine. Brazilian elodea was first reported in 2006 in the Hudson Valley and several locations on Long Island where it is found in 10 lakes and 4 counties. Hydrilla was first reported in 2008 in the lower Hudson Valley and several locations on Long Island where it is found in 5 lakes and 2 counties.

The extension of this program has benefited regional lake associations and municipalities. We have identified samples from numerous area lakes other than Lake George. Most often, the specimens have not been exotic species, and therefore the concerns of lake residents have often been allayed. In the other instances, it has provided the impetus for concerted action on the part of the lake association.

As a part of this program, DFWI maintains an expanding list of sites we have verified to contain Eurasian watermilfoil (Table 2, Figure 1), Waterchestnut (Table 3, Figure 2), Curly-leaf Pondweed (Table 4, Figure 3), Fanwort (Table 5, Figure 4), Variable Milfoil (Table 6, Figure 5), European Frogbit (Table 7, Figure 6), Parrotfeather (Table 8, Figure 7), Starry Stonewort (Table 9, Figure 8), Brazilian Elodea (Table 10, Figure 9) and Hydrilla (Table 11, Figure 10) in New York State. The list remains preliminary, since we currently lack verified sources for many lakes in which these species have been reported to occur. We will only add sites to the list for which an authoritative reference can be given, or for which we have a voucher specimen. We would appreciate receiving reports or other publications listing verified occurrences of these plants.

The Aquatic Plant Identification Program of Rensselaer's Darrin Fresh Water Institute will continue to be offered as a public service during 2009. In order to have samples identified, bring or send them to the DFWI at either the Troy campus or Bolton Landing facility. For more information, see the notice provided as Appendix A of this report.

Figure 1. New York State counties with Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*).

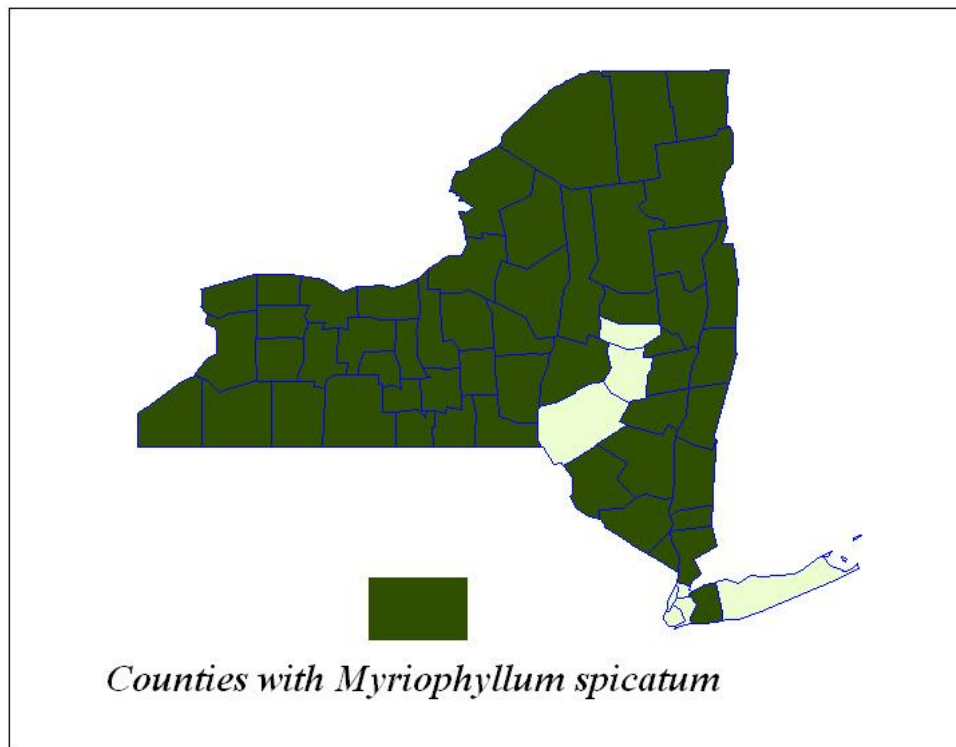

Figure 2. New York State counties with Waterchestnut (*Trapa natans*)

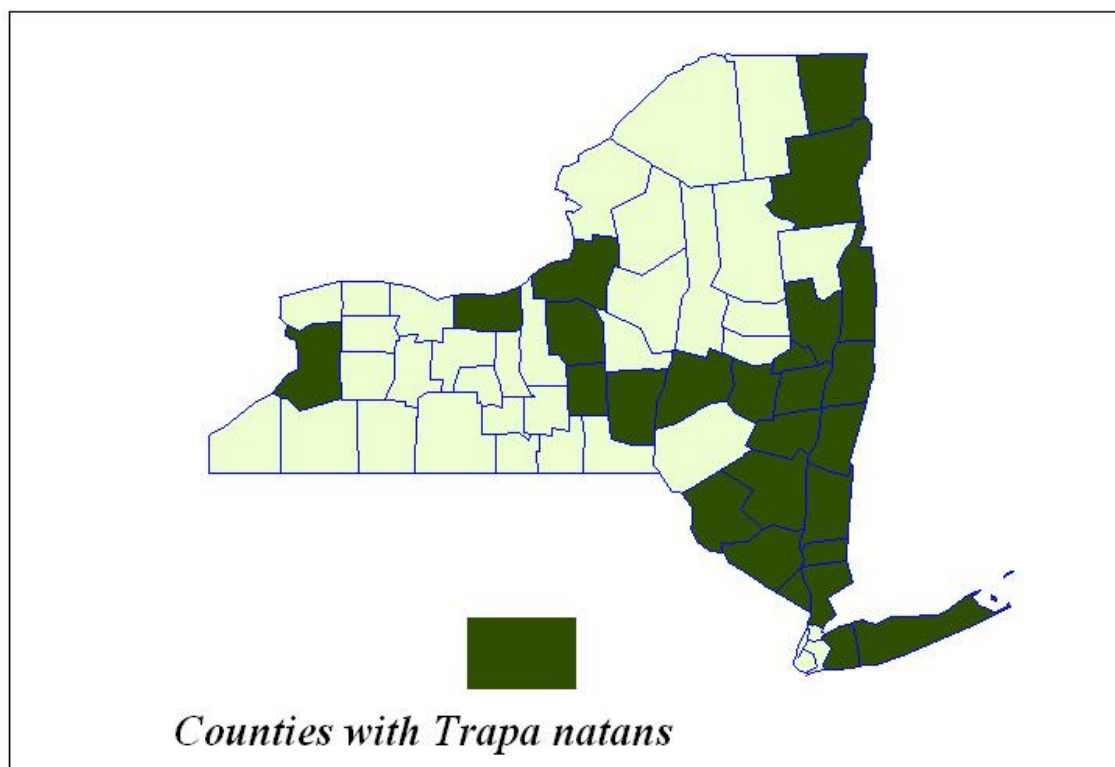

Figure 3. New York State counties with Curly-leaf Pondweed (*Potamogeton crispus*).

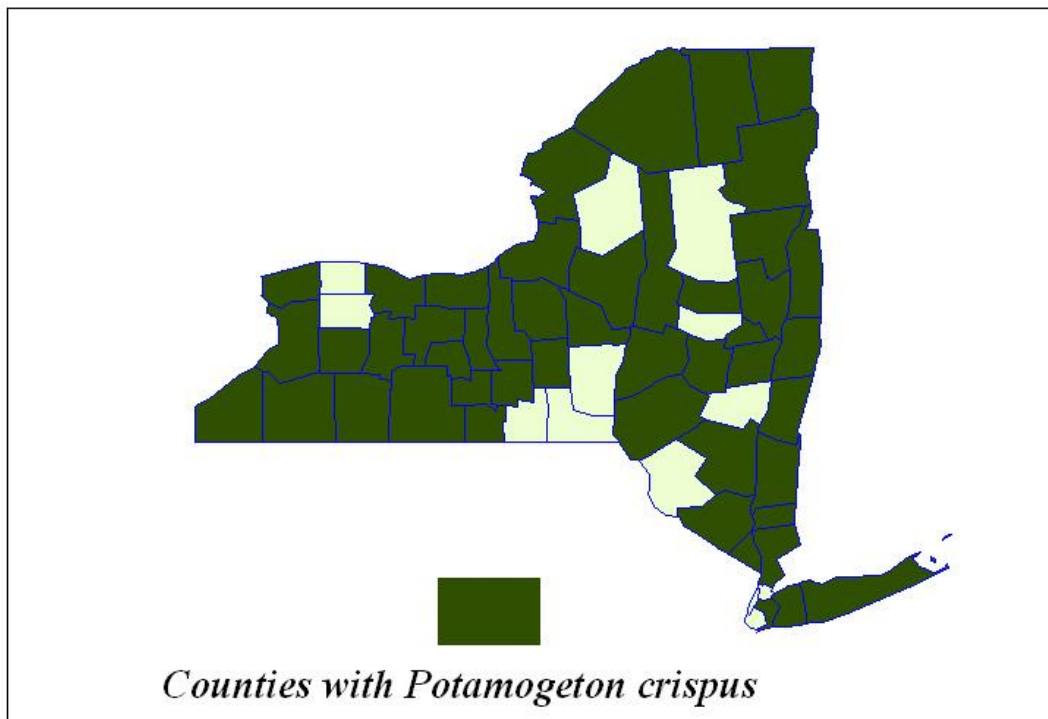

Figure 4. New York State counties with Fanwort (*Cabomba caroliniana*).

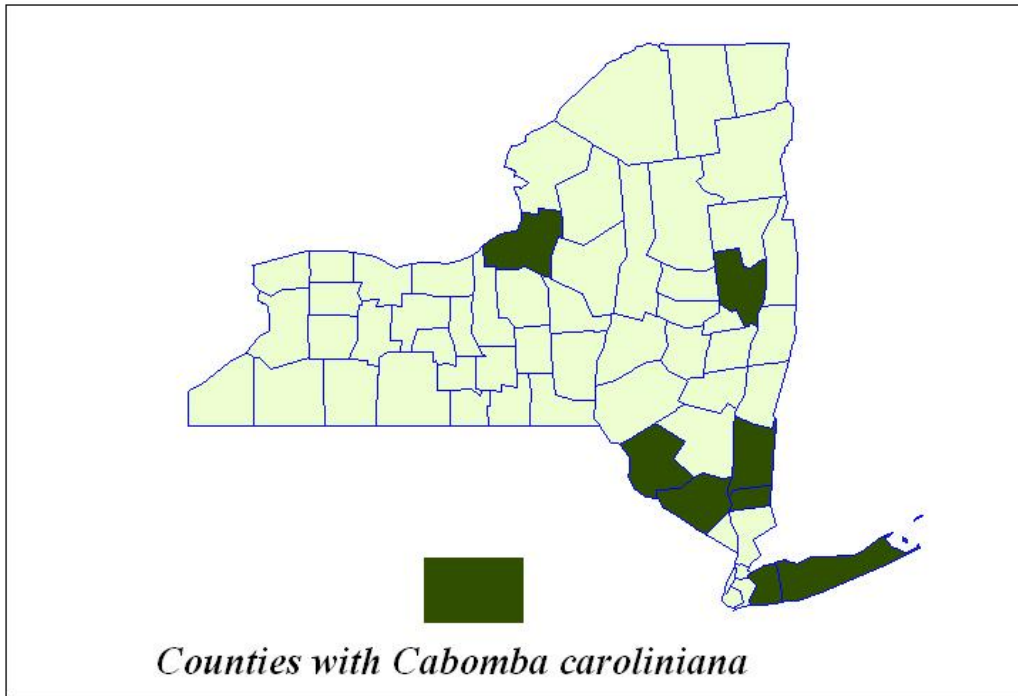

Figure 5. New York State counties with Variable Milfoil (*Myriophyllum heterophyllum*).

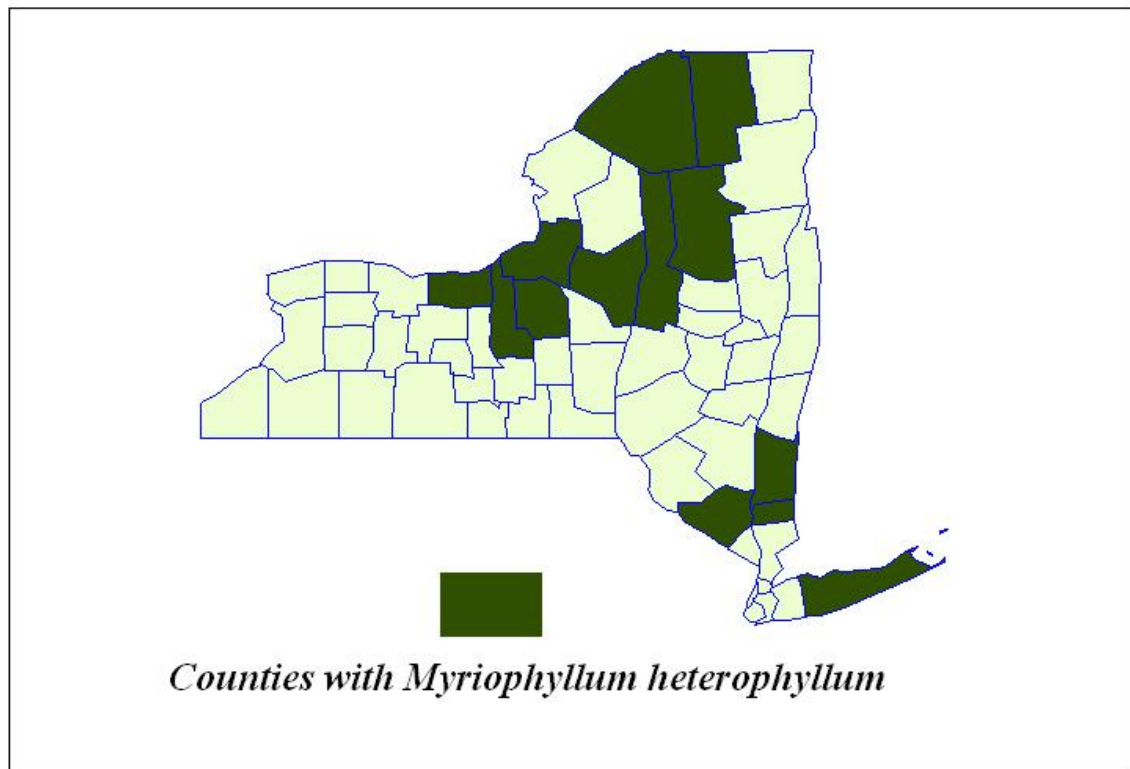

Figure 6. New York State counties with European Frogbit (*Hydrocharis morsus-ranae*)

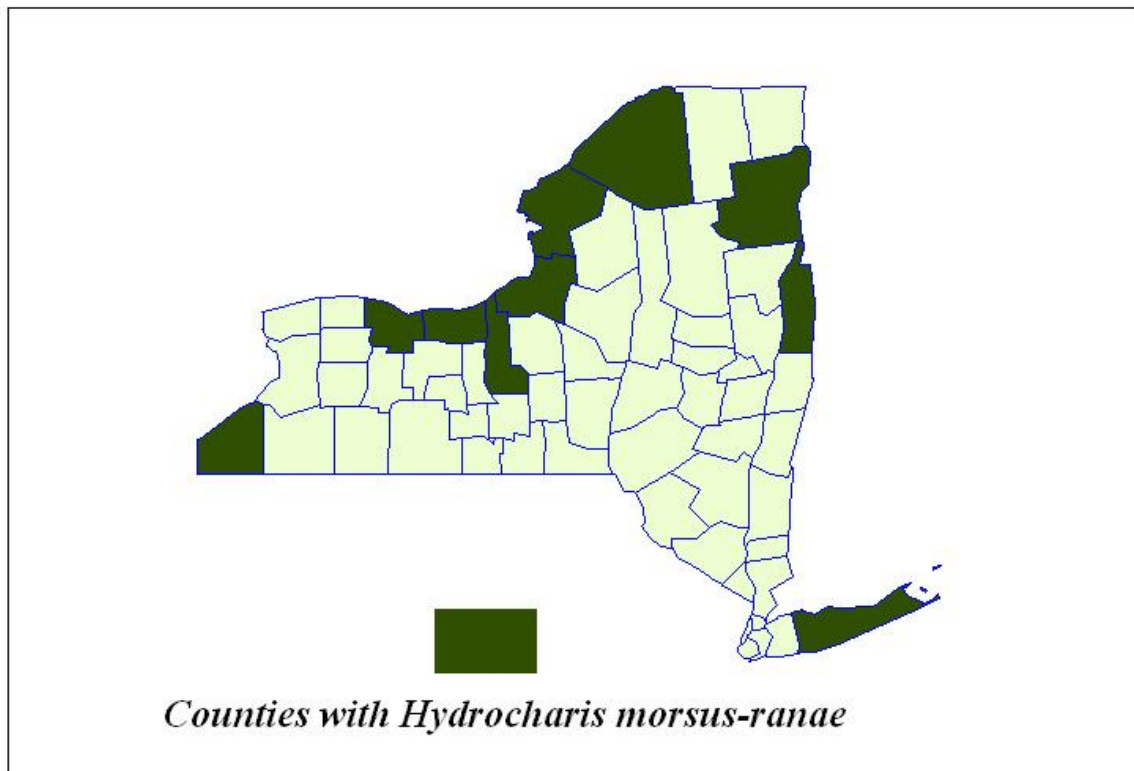

Figure 7. New York State counties with Parrotfeather (*Myriophyllum aquaticum*).

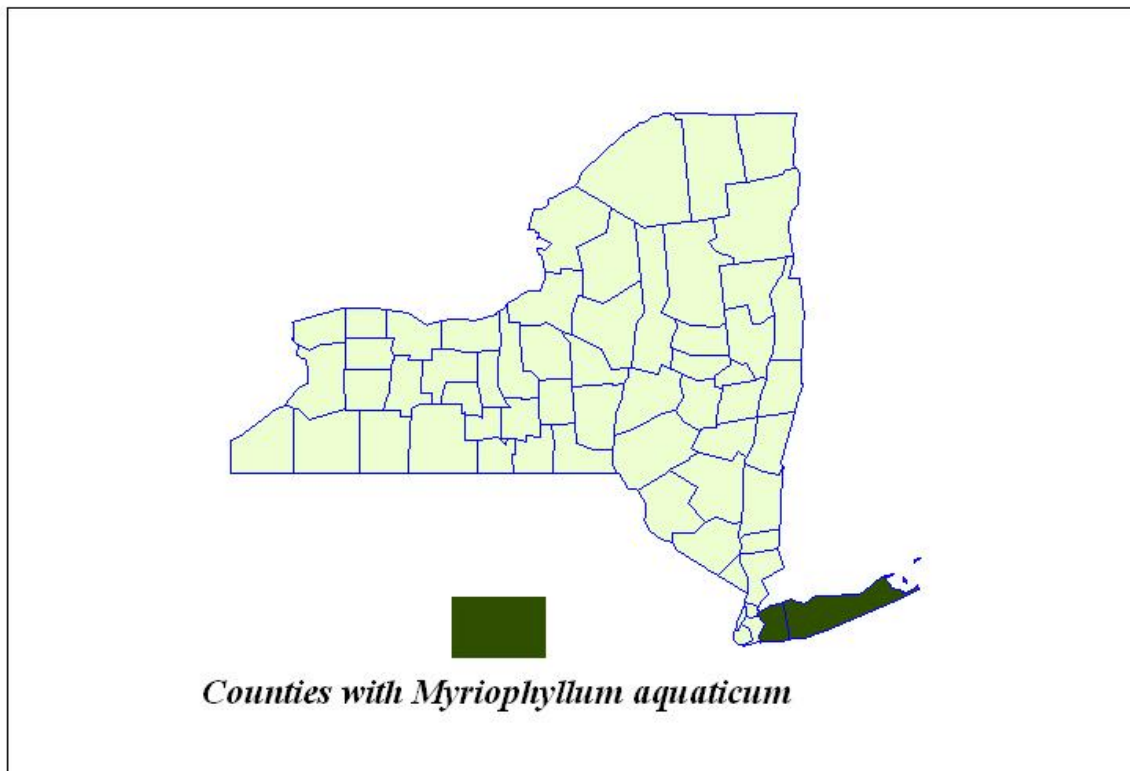

Figure 8. New York State counties with Starry Stonewort (*Nitellopsis obtusa*).

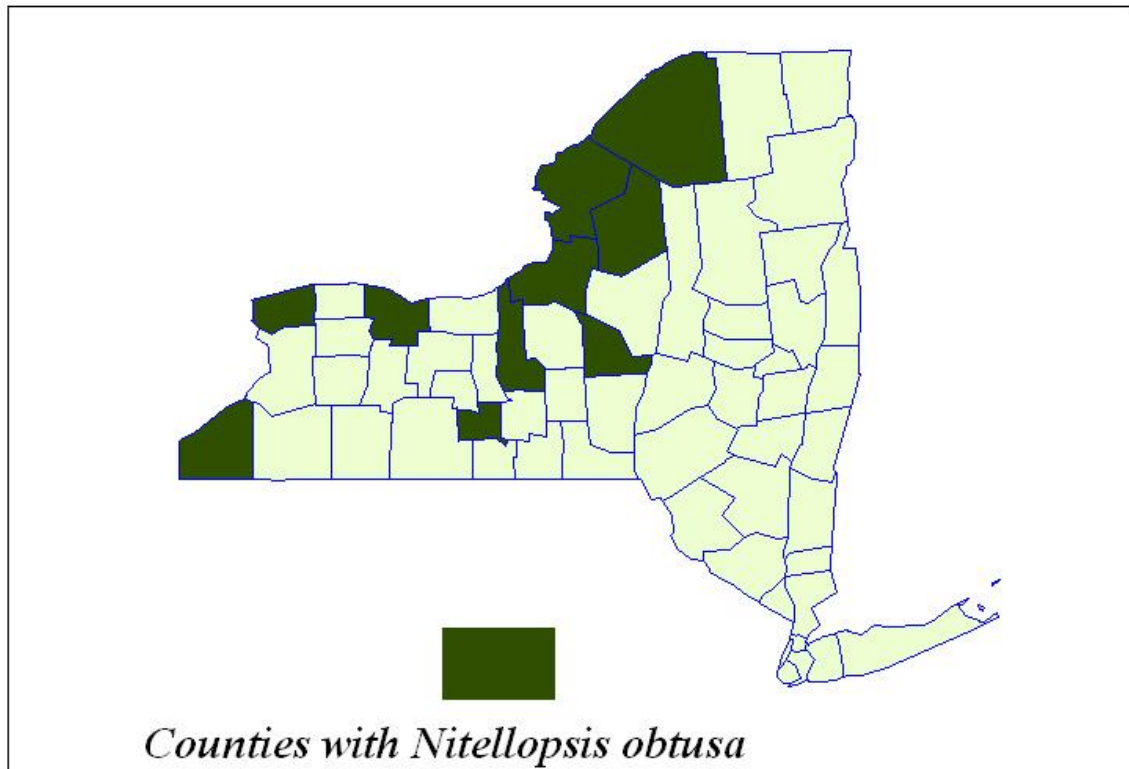

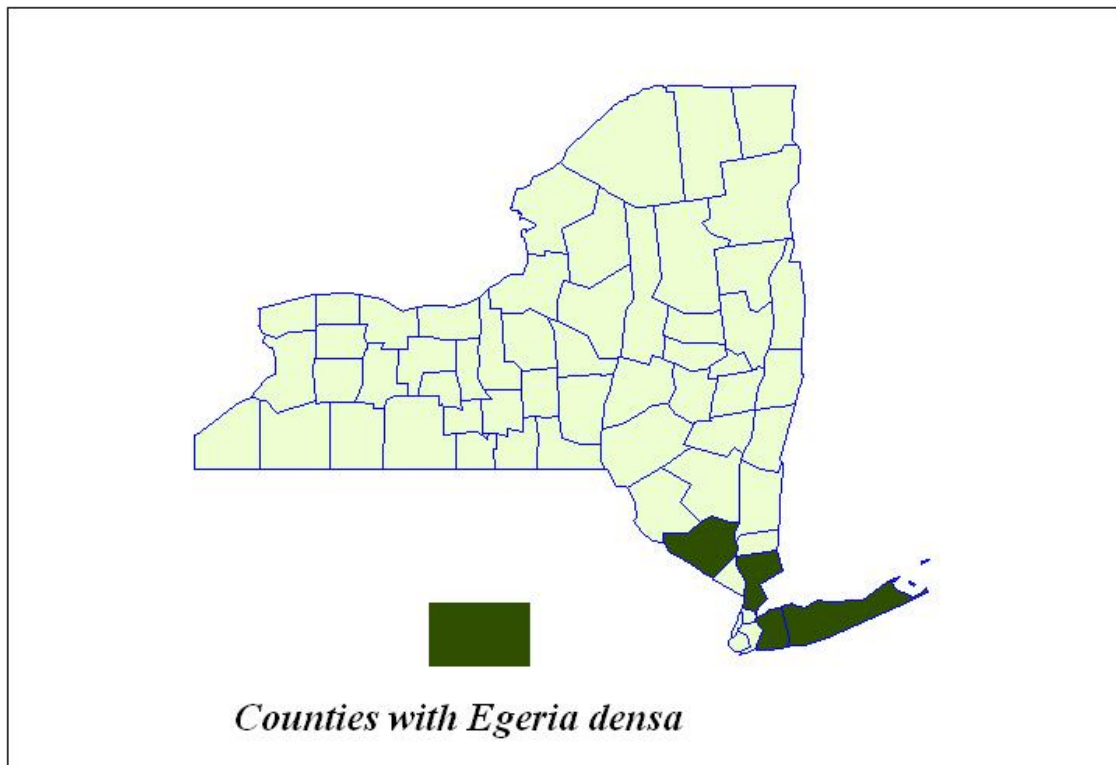
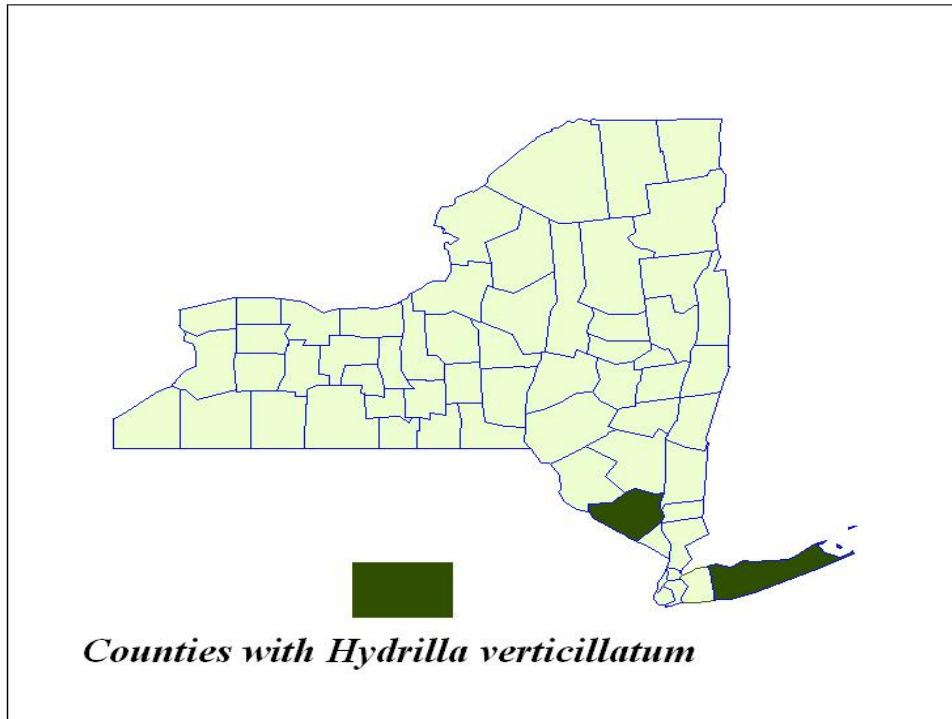
