For the seventeenth year, the Darrin Fresh Water Institute (DFWI) has continued the Aquatic Plant Identification Program. This program was initiated as a public service for the Lake George basin, in which individuals could bring specimens to DFWI for identification. In return, it assisted DFWI in locating new Eurasian Watermilfoil and Curly-leaf Pondweed sites throughout the Lake George basin. DFWI now provides the opportunity for anyone in New York State to have plant specimens verified. This also enables us to maintain a list of locations of invasive aquatic plants such as Waterchestnut (*Trapa natans*), Curly-leaf Pondweed (*Potamogeton crispus*), Eurasian Watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*), and Fanwort (*Cabomba caroliniana*) in New York State. Over the last two years we have added Variable Milfoil (*Myriophyllum heterophyllum*), European Frogbit (*Hydrocharis morsus-ranae*) and Parrotfeather (*Myriophyllum aquaticum*) to our tabulated lists of exotic species in New York State.

During 2004, seven specimens were received and identified (Table 1). None of the specimens were Eurasian watermilfoil, however one specimen of European Frogbit was received. At the conclusion of 2004, 236 lakes in 53 counties had confirmed populations of Eurasian watermilfoil, 80 lakes in 35 counties had confirmed populations of Curly-leaf Pondweed and 13 lakes in 6 counties had Fanwort. Waterchestnut was found mainly in the Hudson and Mohawk Rivers systems, however 44 lakes and 18 counties were reported. European Frogbit is currently reported in 6 lakes and river systems in 4 counties. Variable milfoil is found primarily in the Adirondack Park, however it is reported in 10 lakes across 7 counties. Parrotfeather is only reported for a single location on Long Island.

The extension of this program has benefited regional lake associations and municipalities. We have identified samples from numerous area lakes other than Lake George. Most often the specimens have not been exotic species, and therefore the concerns of lake residents have often been allayed. In the other instances, it has provided the impetus for concerted action on the part of the lake association.

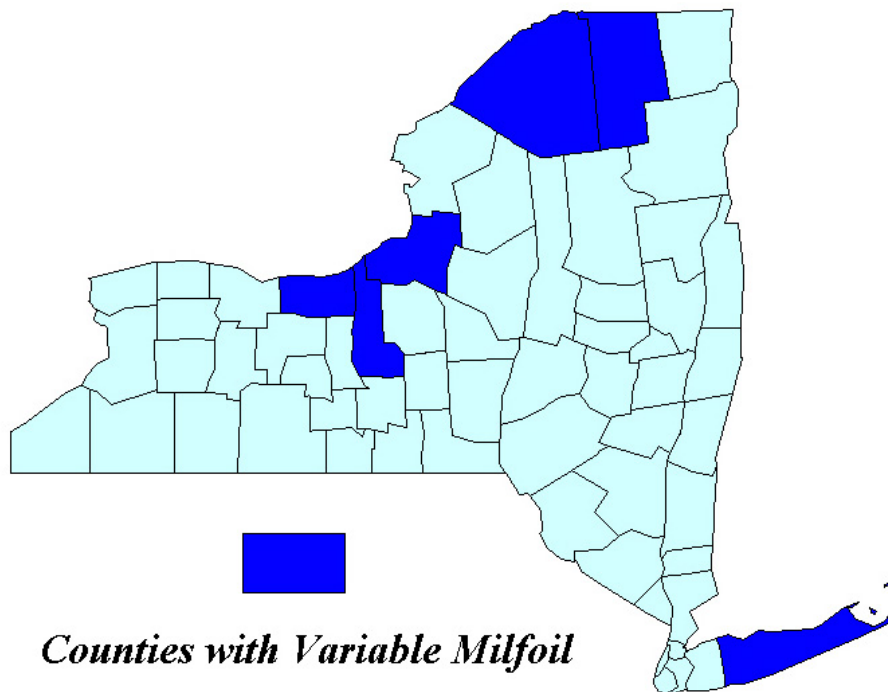
**Figure 4.** New York State counties with Fanwort (*Cabomba caroliniana*).

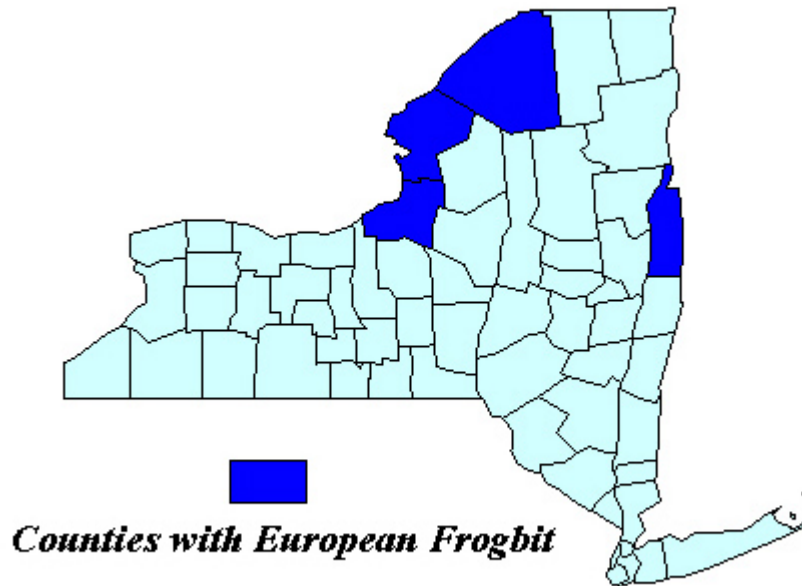
**Figure 5.** New York State counties with Variable Milfoil (*Myriophyllum heterophyllum*).

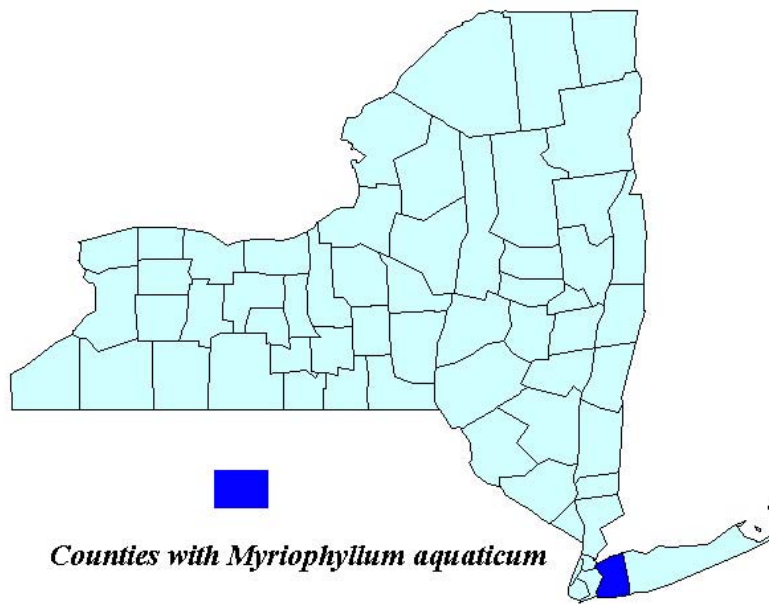
**Figure 6.** New York State counties with European Frogbit (*Hydrocharis morsus-ranae*).

As a part of this program, DFWI maintains an expanding list of sites we have verified to contain Eurasian Watermilfoil (Table 2, Figure 1), Waterchestnut (Table 3, Figure 2), Curly-leaf Pondweed (Table 4, Figure 3), Fanwort (Table 5, Figure 4), Variable Milfoil (Table 6, Figure 5), European Frogbit (Table 7, Figure 6) and Parrotfeather (Table 8, Figure 7), in New York State. The list remains preliminary, since we currently lack verified sources for many lakes in which these species have been reported to occur. We will only add sites to the list for which an authoritative reference can be given, or for which we have a voucher specimen. We would appreciate receiving reports or other publications listing verified occurrences of these plants.

The Aquatic Plant Identification Program of Rensselaer's Darrin Fresh Water Institute will continue to be offered as a public service during 2005. In order to have samples identified, bring or send them to the DFWI at either the Troy campus or Bolton Landing facility. For more information, see the notice provided as Appendix A of this report.

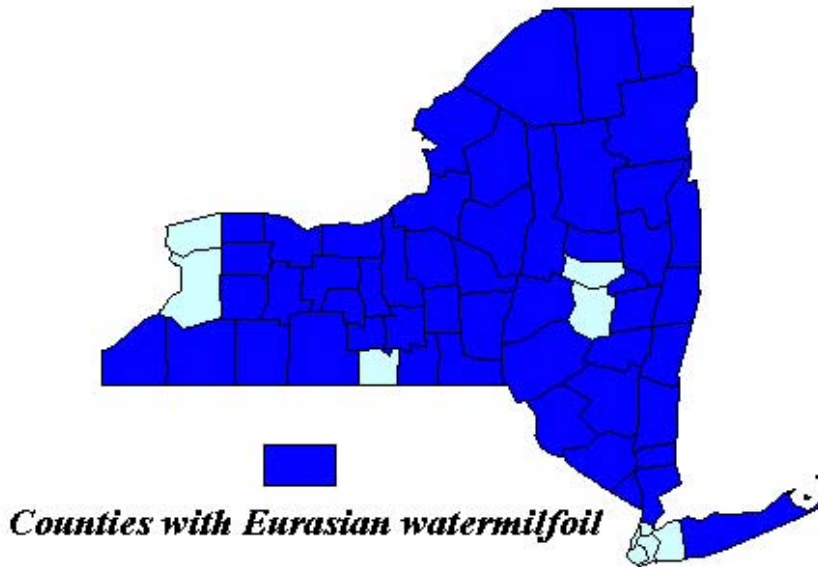

**Figure 1.** New York State counties with Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*).

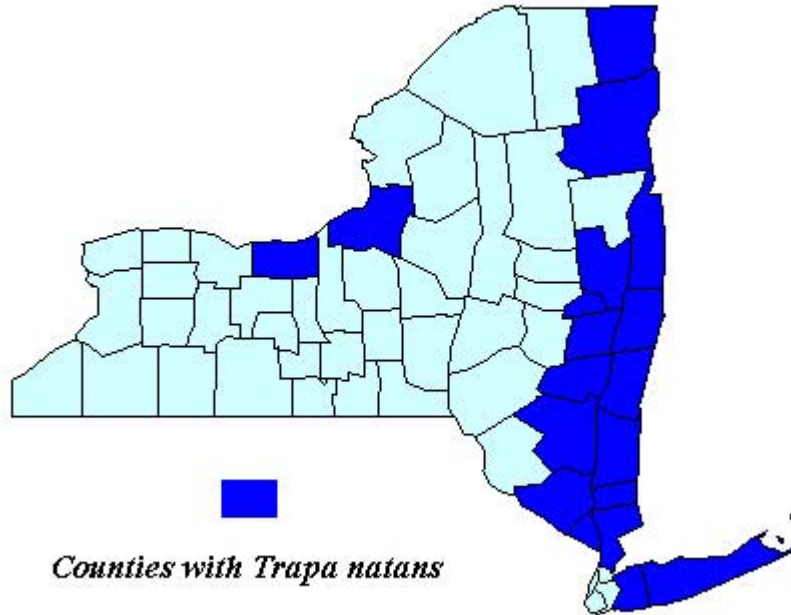

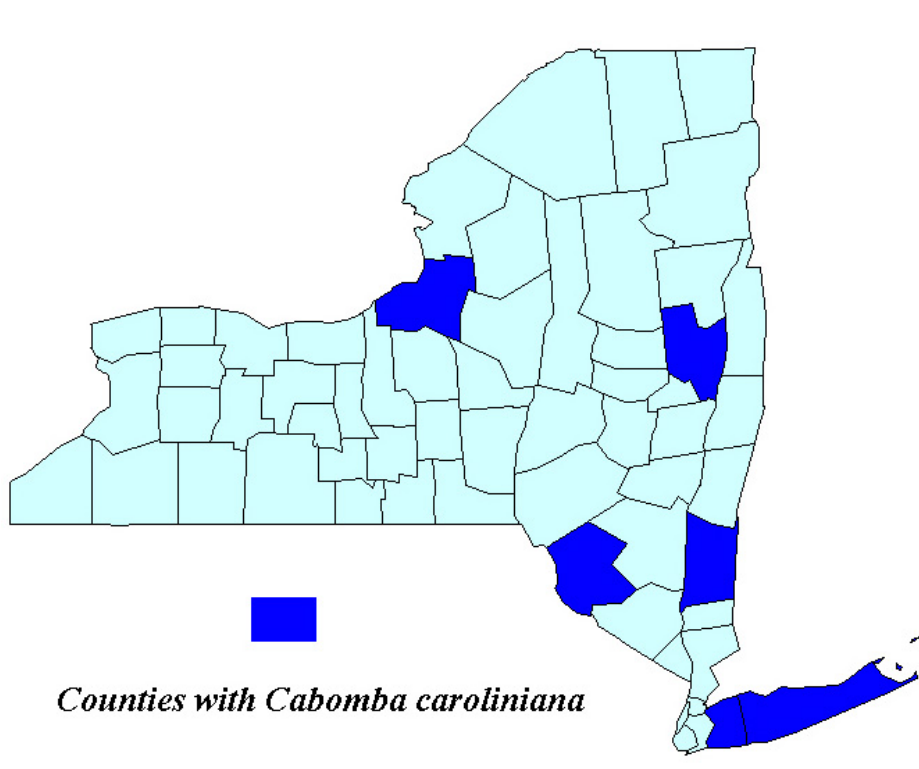
