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ABSTRACT

Space has the capacity to decompress and expand. There are extant fields of space which have phenomenological potential. These are captured, or compressed, as series of two-dimensional records. These documents reveal new potentials of extraction. They expand and inform new space. Spatial phenomena are captured through this extraction of information into a newly expanded space. They reveal phenomena.

The newly exposed field phenomena enrich an architecture which is engaging and contemplative. The user experiences heightened sensitivity to perspective, orientation, and awareness of definitions of space. This effects a simultaneity of Being – “here and there,” “alone and collected,” “near and far.” Most importantly, this architecture is about the things which occur before, between, and beyond these interactions – light, masking, screening, transparency, awareness, consciousness.
